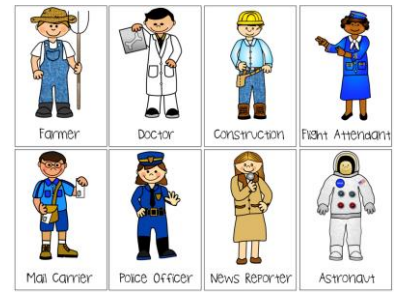

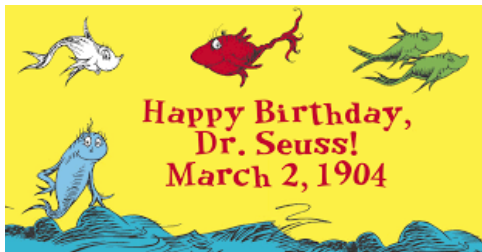


Younger Two's Happenings
