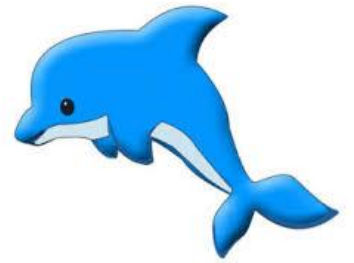




Infant Room Lakeland's Little Learners July 2024
